

Driver's Education

Course Syllabus



Course Description:

Students must take a state approved Driver's Education course, in combination with practice driving with an adult. The total time for class and driving must be submitted in a log format at the end of the semester. This is a pass/fail credit.

End of Course Assessment:

An activity log showing 90 hours of classroom experience, behind-the-wheel training, and practice driving needs to be included in the semester portfolio, along with a copy of the student's driver's license and a certificate, letter, or documentation that the student successfully passed a state approved Driver's Education course. This information should be provided to the contact teacher at the end of the semester.

Course Evaluation:

A grade of Pass or Fail will be entered on the student's report card, depending on assessment documentation provided in the semester portfolio.
